“Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews ? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.” (Matt. 2:1, 2)

As Christmas approaches, our thoughts turn to the wise men of old who took time to find Jesus, the most priceless gift the world has ever known.

Who were these wise men?

The Scripture tells us they were men of the east - Gentiles and strangers to Israel - who came to worship Jesus.

Perhaps most of the Israelites were like we are today - too busy to stop, to ask, and to seek Jesus. If He came again today, would we have a firm knowledge of the Scriptures so that we would recognize Him?

The Bible says, *"He came unto his own, and his own received him not"* (John 1:11).

Oh, the tragedy! They loved not the truth, and they died in their sins. They failed to recognize the Messiah because they loved darkness more than they loved light.

These wise men used the knowledge that God had given them through the Scriptures to discover the star and then followed it to Jerusalem to find Jesus. The popular theory that there were only three wise men is just a tradition; no one knows how many there were. One ancient authority says there were fourteen, but who knows?

The important thing is that when the wise men began to inquire after Christ, they began at that moment to really be wise men. (If we truly desire to know Christ and find Him, we will not regard time, trouble, or work in seeking Him.)

They asked, *"Where is he that is born?"* Not being content with what they already knew, they wanted to know more of the Lord Jesus Christ. And wouldn't this Christmas season be a good time for us to learn more of His love, humility, mercy, goodness, and grace?

Let's worship, honor, love, and adore Him - for He came that we might have life, and that we might have it more abundantly. ♦♦♦

We are so blessed once again with all the Gift Boxes that we have been able to ship to the children in Ukraine. We were able to ship just a few gifts more than 800 in the last 2 containers that we shipped. If it's God's will, we plan to load a container on



November 29th. This container will be shipped to Kiev. We had hoped to surpass the total of 1397 boxes that we shipped in 2017. To make that happen, we will need to pack at least a hundred more boxes this week. We'll see what happens!



It is so good to see the enthusiasm of the young people as they prepare the Gift Boxes, either at the Faith Mission Warehouse, in their church basement, or right in their home. Our prayer is always that each box will include a gift of Love that only Jesus can provide. That is what the children in Ukraine need more than anything money can buy!

We were blessed with hundreds of volunteers who have made it possible for us to ship 7, forty foot, high cube shipping containers. (It's looking like we may even be able to ship Container number 8 before the end of the year.) Faith Mission was also able to finally ship the rollers for the Kharkiv Church. We waited more than a year for the Ukrainian Customs to approve this shipment. God answered our prayers!

We are very thankful for the financial support throughout the year which has allowed us to ship our humanitarian aid and support several other projects overseas. ♦♦♦
