We all thought it was a great idea as it made it a lot more "real" and hands on for the students. We actually had some of the older boys assemble them all. The children were very excited to see all those bikes that we could send to someone in need. We hope they will be a great blessing to someone in need, and if there are ever pictures of people receiving them, we would love to show them to the students. Mr. Thiessen, our bicycle mechanic has been really encouraged with the quality of the bikes that he has serviced and repaired this summer. Earlier in the spring we had requested better bicycles that we could ship overseas and we are very grateful for the response. Thank you very much!

I have mentioned this many times before but I know many people here in Canada can not fathom the poverty that so many of the people in Ukraine deal with on a daily basis. They just do not



have the resources to own a vehicle or if they have a vehicle they likely can not afford the fuel. That is why the bicycle ministry is such an important part of our ministry.

We have been blessed with lots of excellent clothing! This photo shows our Clothing Bin #2, filled to the top..... I guess it's higher than the top of the bin!

Lately we have not been able to keep up with what has been donated but we are looking forward to having



more groups coming in this fall and winter to sort and bale. Although it is always difficult to get volunteers to help us out during the summer months, our Thursday afternoon team has been faithfully sorting and baling. We are planning to ship another container on October 3rd.

Thanks again for the wonderful response to the Gift Box Ministry - Merry Christmas!

Praise the Lord! It looks like we will be able to put more than 700 Gift Boxes into the container going out this week. For many of us here in Canada it is "just a box of stuff!" However, for those children in the villages of Ukraine, it is possibly the only gift they get all year....maybe this is the first Christmas Gift they have ever received. It is so much more than a box of stuff! When they open the package, they experience the "Love of Jesus" that was included when it was packed here in Canada. Many of these children hear the Story of the Birth of Jesus for the first time in their life before the gifts are distributed. It gives us a heart full of joy, just thinking of how many families have been touched, inspired and saved through the Gift Box Ministry. We want to thank all of you for supporting this project, either by packing a gift, providing funds so that we can pack the gifts or by praying for this very exciting part of Faith Mission. Another Camp Season has come and gone!

Thank God, it is only through your support that Faith Mission has again been able to support several Children's Summer Camps this year. We were able to support the Sucholessy Camp which is approximately 100 kilometers from Kiev. This Camp is managed by the Uzin Church. We have visited the Sucholessy Camp a number of times and are very excited about the various special camps that they host during the year, e.g. Children's Camp, Youth Camp, Widow's Camp, and a Camp for People With Disabilities.





The top photo was taken at the Sucholessy Children's Camp. The second photo was taken at the same camp. Every summer they host a camp for people struggling with disabilities. This is a very special outing for the disabled people in Ukraine because they are often left in institutions where care is minimal. Our hope and prayer is that God will touch the hearts of these people and that they can accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior. We also pray that God will continue to bless and encourage those people who take the time to work with these less fortunate people at the camp or wherever they are. For most of these situations, resources are extremely limited so they have to get by with what they have.

Faith Mission has supported and partially sponsored the Carpathian Children's Camp for 15 years. Our first year of Camp support was in 2004 when we were made aware of the impact that the Children's Camp Ministry had, especially on the people in the Ukrainian villages.
