Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go into such and such a town and spend a year there and trade and make a profit" — yet you do not know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little time and then vanishes. Instead you ought to say, "If the Lord wills, we will live and do this or that." As it is, you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil. James 4:13-16

The Bible is quite clear:

Everyone must "fear the Lord."

Today, we'll look at why it is not only obedient for men to fear the Lord, but also logical and beneficial.

Psalm 33:8 says, "Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the people of the world revere him." And then the rest of the Psalm goes on to explain plainly why this is so. The Lord created everything. He foils the plans of the nations. He sees all mankind from above. He forms the hearts of all men. He can deliver from death. His love is unending. It doesn't take that much serious contemplation to realize that it is extremely foolish not to fear the Lord. The greatest men in the Bible were not the ones who had it all together or accomplished the greatest deeds. No, the greatest men were those who learned to fear the Lord.

Consider Abraham: God established a covenant with Abraham in which God would bless him and make him into a great nation, that he might be a blessing to the entire world (Genesis 12:2-3). How could that be possible? How could a man born 4,000 years ago be a blessing to us today? Well, one of Abraham's offspring, born 2,000 years after him, was none other than Jesus Christ! And through Jesus, all people have the chance to be forgiven and to receive eternal life! All people could be blessed! And God did not say to Abraham, "Go and bless the whole

world." Rather, He said, "Through you, I will bless the whole world." God made the covenant to Abraham when he was 75. Abraham was childless. How could his offspring bless the whole world if he didn't even have one kid? Abraham tried to make this future happen on his own. But this was doomed to failure; he could not create that future. God wanted Abraham to realize that his whole future came from the Lord. Abraham finally had a child twenty-five years later! It was a miracle that only God could do. And Jesus did come two millennia later. God kept up His side of the covenant. Men, a significant part of fearing the Lord is trusting Him completely with your future and understanding that it is He, not you, who is in charge of it. Fear the Lord and rely utterly on Him.

Prayer: Dear Lord, you know my heart, my dreams, my impatience, my limited understanding. Thank You for Your mercy and kindness in forgiving me when I act as if I were the captain of my own destiny. You are the One who knows all things and can do all things. You have a plan for my life. Please, Jesus, help me to be still and wait patiently on You. I commit, not only the far future to You, but this day as well. Have Your way in me. Amen.

Children's camps in the Carpathians 2026

Greetings to the dear friends of the Mission in the Lord and to everyone who donated to these wonderful services in summer camps with children whose lives are just beginning. Peace be with you.

Preparation for the next camps will practically begin as soon as the previous ones end, when we invite teachers who are leaving home for the next year. This is important because without them ministry is impossible. And thank God that God is coming from different places in Ukraine this year for these services. This year there were 15 camps planned. How to conduct, how many camps you can only understand when, with God's help and with many friends, you conduct all these services. Of course, first we pray to our Lord, all for His glory and through Him. We asked the teachers how long they could come, then we began to negotiate with the administration of the village, schools, and club. Then how to feed the children, the cook, where to feed so that sanitary standards are met so that there is no poisoning, this is a special question. And how many different purchases, in different markets and stores. More than two tons of bottled water alone were purchased for the camps already held. Preparation of premises in different places, bases on Staishch, in addition to our Carpathian

More than 2000 children attended in more than 15 different camps this past summer thanks to Faith Mission support. Many children have heard about Christ through these many camps. Willing workers that gave so freely of their time, together with the donations of so many supporters made this possible. Inside you will find testimonies from numerous children that attended camps and how their lives were changed by them.



camps on Staisch, 7 more camps from different Churches of Ukraine, these are also our experiences. Of course, these are funds without which we can't do it either; we are grateful to God for all the Western Churches that donated through the Mission for these ministries.

To date, 11 camps have already been held. We started at Grinyava school on June 8, then for the first time we spent time in the village of Gramotnoye at school. Then, from June 22 to July 3, camps were held in Dovgopol at school, Rivnya House of Prayer, Bukovets school, Iltsy club, Red club, Khodak school, Verkhovyna school, Staishche Baza and Yablunitsa club. More than 1,500 children attended these services along with their teachers. In addition to the children in such camps as Grinyava, Gramnoye, Yablunitsa, there were many parents who came in the morning and were there with their children until the end of the day, listening and watching what was happening. We also fed them for lunch, and all day long they had coffee, tea, sweets, etc. Of course, there was a Christian library for everyone, conversations about the possibility of repentance and living faith in God.

The village of Yablunitsa, of course, as always, surprises and delights, one might say that the days of the camp are a holiday for the village. When, from the very morning, children and many parents come from different streets, from different villages of the district, the atmosphere is very friendly, everyone is greeted and seen off with a smile. The village headman is very grateful that they are doing something for their people in the village. It seems to me that he is the most pleased of all



Both outdoors to indoors, the children enjoy the opportunity to gather and hear about God, whether it is there first time at a Christian camp or they are experienced "veterans". The hunger for God is alive in so many of these young souls. Yes, many of them are likely drawn to camp because of the "fun" things they are able to do there or because they are fed 3 good meals per day there but the truth of the matter is that the life-changing part of camp isn't the games or crafts but hearing about the truth of God's Love.



these days. Of course, there are those who are not happy about all this, but this is a very small number, the most dissatisfied are the Orthodox priests, in almost all villages, but that is another question. You can understand them to some extent, although they often say in their churches that parents should not let their children in. But there are very few of them who listen to this issue. And we are grateful to God that our Jesus Christ is preached in our Carpathian region. About 400 children and adults gathered in Yablunytzia on the last day. A choir came from one of the churches in Chernivtsi, the teachers were also from this church. And at the end there was a service only for parents separately in the club. All the children passed through the location at the stadium at this time. The choir sang beautifully and the brothers preached. Friends, this atmosphere can only be fully experienced by being a participant in these services.

Our God was exalted and glorified in all camps. Hundreds of New Testaments, Jesus Our Destiny and many different children's literature were distributed. But there are still three camps ahead.

August 10th A team from Odessa comes to Tuchapi, invited by Victor, he is also in charge of the camp there.

In the village Velikiy Kuchurov and s. Godylov will be at the club and school, if God willing there will be camps. I'll give you information about that later.

In five camps we distributed clothes at the end of the day, and many parents came.

Friends, we will connect the camp that we planned at the boarding school with the camp at Staishche. Every day we transport children from Verkhovyna with beads. The boarding school was undergoing renovations and could not accept us, but mostly the children who were supposed to be there were at Staishche.

After the end of the camps, God willing, I think we will hold one-day meetings on the eve of the school year in two places; there are not many backpacks received in the winter from friends of the Mission. I'll write about that later.

My dear brothers, I thank God that we have you and your service brings a lot of joy to children and God. Proclaiming Our Jesus Christ to the younger generation is the most beautiful thing that can happen in the life of a Christian. And we pray that these opportunities will continue, no matter what, no matter the obstacles that may arise, and that the war, unfortunately, continues. This has always been the case, throughout all Christian times. The main thing is that Christ promised on the mountain in Galilee: And this, I am with you always, until the end of the age. Amen. Matthew 28.20

Greetings, dear friends of the mission. So the summer ended in the camps that were held in different places and villages. Educators who came from different parts of Ukraine, all together, there were many parents with educators, the service staff was about 2000 people. In the last days of summer, two one-day camps were held before the new school year. In Hodyliv, in the house of prayer, children of soldiers who died in the war, widows and children whose fathers are currently on the front line, were invited. Friends of Hodyliv's church prepared a program. At the end, backpacks were distributed, which we received from the mission in winter and have kept until now. There was also a

A simple little tent to keep the sun out of their eyes, a teacher passionate and caring about their salvation, patiently explaining the Gospel to these children. At first glance that is what we see in this picture and that in itself is beautiful.

But as you can see in the background of the picture to the right, this camp is being held in a park right beside the town's memorials to their fallen soldiers, there is a very real possibility that there are children who have family members on those plaques. They understand death and the need for salvation in a very real way.



meeting with backpacks in the village of Perekresnoye, in the Carpathians, where parents were also invited. On August

25, there was a meeting with the children on the eve of the school year, there was a program, excellent communication, a limited number of children were invited, since we no longer had backpacks. Several backpacks were raffled, which remained among 80 children. But friends at Staishche prepared modest gifts so that each participant could go home with something.

On July 26, there was a baptism in the village of Rivnya, two brothers made a covenant with God. On August 30, the baptism was in the Hodyliv church, three young people promised to serve God all their lives. During the summer, there were meetings with adults in different villages, with the distribution of humanitarian aid in the form of clothes, flour from Canada and onions, which were shared by friends from another church. There was a meeting with the migrants, they are always waiting for meetings and are glad for everything that they will be given. God willing, there will soon be another meeting with the refugees in Verkhovyna, we promised flour, soups and dry potatoes from Canada for a long time. Thank God that soon the cargo from the mission from Canada will be brought to Tuchapi. We will share everything that the friends from the mission have loaded into a container. Of course, we will leave some of the flour, dry potatoes and soups in reserve. They promise a very difficult winter, but the Lord is our shepherd and hope, He promised to be always with us. Friends, we are grateful to God that again and again we can work together with you and have the opportunity, to conduct all these ministries with children and adults. Without your material support it is impossible. We are grateful to all the churches in Europe and North America that financially support the ministry of missions.

Now some feedback from children about camps, what they think about them:

1. Ivanka: Every day begins with prayer, which gave motivation and hope for the whole day. In Bible lessons, we learned interesting stories, learned to be kind, honest and support each other. The educators were incredibly generous; they were always ready to listen and help.

2. Dina: the camp motivates me to pray more and always be with God, as well as to go to church more.

3. It was a wonderful time at camp. I liked the Bible stories, I learned more about God, I especially liked the story about Esther, how she trusted God in difficult circumstances.

4. Tanya: The story of Joseph, stuck in my heart, because even though he was sold by his brothers, he could forgive them and even take care of them. This camp taught me how to communicate better with God. My favourite song is "Hope, You Are Mine".

1. You are my hope in the midst of stormy worries! You are protection, my hope! Wonderful is Your Name, my Creator and God! I am Your creation, God.

I run to You in my prayer, I know, God, that You hear me

As you read through this song imagine singing it as a child/youth that lives in a country that is currently at war. Never knowing when/where the next missile strike or drone will hit.

5. Thank you to the camp for this week. Each day was unique in its own way. We played, sang, laughed, but most of all I did not remember the lessons about God. They helped me learn more about God and understand that He is always there.

7. This camp is a place where you want to return. There is an atmosphere of love, mutual respect and joy. Every day was filled with different lessons, we played and communicated. Most of all, I liked the lessons that helped me look at many things in my life in a new way. The camp gave me a lot that will be remembered for a lifetime. May the Lord bless everyone who organized this camp.

8. At the camp, I learned a lot from Bible stories and learned how to work better as a team and help others.

As we approach the Christmas season we are also busy working on our Christmas Gift box project again as well. God has blessed us in so many ways the last few years and we see that as much in our gift box project as anywhere. This is the fastest growing part of Faith Mission. We were able to nearly double the number of gift boxes sent in 2025 than we did only 3 years earlier in 2022. For 2026 we already have several additional churches that have committed to fill boxes for us that make it likely that we will break all records from previous years. With a target for this year to fill 10,000 boxes, this project would cost us \$350,000+ if we were to fill all these boxes from scratch and although we do plan to fill about 1,900 start to finish in 2026, most of the boxes are filled by supporting individuals and churches and we only need to add a few items here and there. Our total cost from our general fund last year for the 7,105 gift boxes we sent was only \$7,778, this was largely due to a large fundraiser we had in August 2025 specifically to support the gift box project.



Another two projects that we are passionate about are the "Warm Hearts/Warm Homes" and the "Food Package" project. The Warm Hearts project sees homes that would otherwise remain cold in the winter be able to get heated by firewood or coal that we purchased with funds raised in Canada and Germany. Having been there personally a few times to distribute this firewood to the various homes helps me to understand the necessity of projects like this one. (The homes that receive this help are not meant to live solely off the help they receive but the intention is more that we are supplementing what they are doing on their own). For many of the recipients the firewood that it takes to heat their home for a month is the same as half a month's wages and in some cases even over half of their income is spent heating their house. At that point they come to the very difficult decision to make, do we buy food and live cold or do we buy wood and go hungry? This is not the either/or choice we feel they should need to make so we come alongside



and provide them with a little bit of firewood, about 1 months' worth per winter. Viktor from Central Ukraine who buys wood pallets to heat the church where he serves sent us the following comparisons: In 2024, he bought pellets for UAH 5,800 per ton (approx. \$196 CAD), $196 \times 23.1 = \$4,528$ CAD. In the summer of 2025, he bought at UAH 8,300 per ton (\$278 CAD), $278 \times 23.1 = \$6,421$ CAD. Now, in 2026, the price is already 16,500 UAH per ton (approx. \$521 CAD) $521 \times 23.1 = \$12,035$ CAD.

Canada Presentation Tour 2026

As I mentioned in the previous newsletter we are planning a tour of Canada with our friend, Alex Janzen, from Missionswerk FriedensBote in Germany. Alex will be sharing on the topic "Between War and Persecution: The Life of Christians in the Former Soviet Union" going into detail about what life is like for the Christians in the former Soviet Union. How is it different from what we know and experience in North America?

The plan is that Alex will fly to Calgary and begin our presentations in La Crete AB. From there we will make our way South and East ending 22 days later in Gowanstown, ON.

In 2022, we did a similar tour where we saw over 5000 people that attended 34 presentations. This time we have a few less days because of time constraints but we are hoping for good turn-outs and praying that we will have just as good a time as we did then. There are still a few day time possibilities if you would like him to come and speak to school or senior groups please contact us and we would be happy to discuss that option with you as well.

To the left are the tentative dates/locations for all the planned presentations, aside from schools and Sunday morning church services are not listed. Posters for these events will be going out in our WhatsApp chat and this list, including any changes, will be kept up to date on our website as well.
